The fallowing is required:

- 1. Transcript of high school credits
- 2. GPA of 2.3 or above

The following information must be typed, or computer generated:

- 1. Letter of recommendation for a teacher in subject matter of major interest.
- 2. Letter of recommendation from a community leader, clergy or employer.
- 3. An autobiography of no more than 200 words.
- 4. Completed application form.

It selected as a scholarship recipient, the student will receive a one time \$1000.00 scholarship award. A check will be made payable to the recipient once verification that a 2.3 or better GPA was achieved on all attempted fulltime course work for the first semester/quarter of enrollment.

The Committee on Education and Scholarships will select recipients for scholarship awards. The scholarships are selected on the basis of academic record, future potential and participation in school and community activities, statement of career and educational aspirations and goal, recommendation and financial need. To ensure that no bias occurs in the selection process for award of scholarships, all

Interested applications, (local high school seniors) must meet the criteria established in the guidelines and application of the program. As an internal quality control measure, the committee on Education and Scholarships selects recipients for scholarship award based on needs during the selection process and not by the applicant's being affiliated with our organization (spouse, family member, etc.). All applicants agree to accept the decision of the Committee of Education and Scholarships. The FOSB Scholarship Committee may interview final candidates.

Interested students should complete the application and submit it to the McIntosh Academy Guidance Office By April 15, of the current school year.

Applications received after this date will not be considered. Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applicants are evaluated on the information submitted to the committee by a rubric outline format. Scholarship recipients will be announced at Honors Night in May of each year.
